

Turn & (Sun)Burn

*Youth competitors
beat the heat at the
Summer World Show with the
help of their speedy Paint Horses.*

Though temperatures soared in Fort Worth, Texas, during late June, Youth competitors brought their own kind of heat to the Will Rogers Coliseum June 28. Riders streaked around barrels, poles and stakes to vie for world championship titles at the 2010 Summer World Show.

Glenn Stodart, 12, of Wynnewood, Oklahoma, took home his first world championship at the 2010 Youth Summer World Show after piloting the 2001 sorrel overo mare Flipmia Verse to win Youth Barrel Racing 13 & Under with a time of :17.204.

Glenn has shared "Pokey" with his mom, Lea, for about two years. Pokey and Lea are the 2008 world champions in Amateur Pole Bending, but this was Glenn's first time to compete with the mare in barrel racing at the World Show. Last year, the pair competed in Youth Pole Bending 13 & Under.

"Barrel racing just looked fun, and I wanted to try something new," said Glenn. "I know I'm not the best out there, but I strive to be. Pokey likes to run. She loves her job."

One former racehorse found a new winner's circle of sorts at the Summer World Show. Paired with Shelton Headley of Port Gibson, Mississippi, the 2003 gray tobiano mare Shez Quick N Easy Too placed fourth in Youth Barrel Racing 14–18, with a time of :17.986. The mare is sired by the 1983 Champion Running 2-Year-Old Easy Jet Too and is out of Rabbit Redux AQHA, a granddaughter of legendary Quarter Horse race sire First Down Dash.

Prior to her barrel-racing career, Shez Quick N Easy Too started on the track seven times. She placed second once and third twice and acquired \$2,292 in earnings on the track.

Amanda Morris, 19, of Hurst, Texas, nearly missed the Summer World Show this year. The college freshman had taken

a break from competing to concentrate on school. But just five days before the event, she made the decision to compete one last time, pulling her trusty rodeo mount Boston Quixote out of a yearlong retirement.

Legging up the gelding and practicing as much as she could, Amanda simply hoped for good runs in her events. When the dust settled, Amanda and the 1997 sorrel tobiano gelding had done the unthinkable: They earned world champion titles in Youth Barrel Racing 14–18 and Youth Pole Bending 14–18, clocking times of :17.425 and :21.749, respectively. Their feat marks the first time a horse-and-rider duo has won both events in the same year since 1999.

"I thought, 'It's my last year, I might as well go and have fun,'" said Amanda. "I've done this for years and come close, but I've never won. Just seeing my mom and dad so excited was worth it. I'm overjoyed."

One thing's for certain—the Summer World Show is a special event for Youth, and they continue to turn up the heat every year.

"I love the events here at the World Show," said Amanda. "I love the adrenaline rush and the atmosphere. I just love coming here."

Gaining steam in their second year on the World Show schedule, the Novice Youth speed events saw an increase in entries across the board from 2009. Heather Lang Buck, a 19-year-old from Colorado Springs, Colorado, guided the 1998 sorrel overo mare Miss Fancy News to win the Novice Youth Stake Race 18 & Under with a time of :09.397. The pair had shown in other events at past World Shows, but this was their first year to try speed events and their inaugural win at the breed's pinnacle Youth show.

Following the Summer World Show, Heather suffered a serious accident, says her father, Richard. She's recovering slowly, but Richard says Heather was thrilled with her success at the show.

"She was so excited," said Richard. "She beamed and smiled for almost an hour, she was so happy. It made her day—her life, probably. She loves the World Show." **PHR**
