

APHA Turn & Earn Slot Class

The following Turn & Earn slot classes will be offered at the 2012 APHA World Championship Show: Regular Registry and Solid Paint-Bred Barrel Racing and Regular Registry and Solid Paint-Bred Pole Bending classes.

Purchase

- Slots will be purchased on a yearly basis with a maximum of 30 slots per class.
- APHA reserves the right to adjust the number of slots sold according to response.
- Horse and Exhibitor must be named by September 10, 2012.
- A \$50 late fee will be applied each time payment is late.
- Late enrollment will be accepted until 5 p.m. the day before the class (\$600 + \$100) = \$700

Turn & Earn Slot Payment Schedule:

\$200 due with application by March 31, 2012

\$200 due June 30, 2012

\$200 due September 10, 2012

Total slot: \$600

Late Payments

June 30, 2012: \$50 + Payments to date

September 11, 2012 to 5 p.m. day before class: \$100 + Payments to date

Ownership

- The owner listed on the APHA Turn & Earn Slot nomination form is the owner of the slot, regardless of the horse shown. The current slot owner has the first right of refusal of that slot for the life of the Turn & Earn Program or until that right is relinquished by not
- Limit of two slots per class per each Immediate Family Unit, see the APHA Rule Book, Rule SC-160.N.
- The slot owner must be a current APHA member.

Horse & Exhibitor Nominations

- · No World Show qualification required for slot classes only.
- By signing the APHA Turn & Earn Slot nomination form, the owner confirms that the named horse and exhibitor are eligible to show in the slot class. Exhibitor must be a current APHA member
- \$150 will be retained to cover the cost of class entry fees, administrative fees, drug testing, audit and office processing fees. Stall fees not included.
- · Horse substitutions and/or refunds are only allowable upon death of the horse. Vet certificate required.
- Horse and Exhibitor must be named by September 10, 2012 when final payment is due; or at the time final payment is made if later than September 10.
- Exhibitor substitutions may be made until 5 p.m. the day before the slot class with a \$50 fee.

Rules:

- All earnings are paid to the slot owner.
- All disputes arising out of the application or interpretation of any rules or conditions of this program will be decided by APHA.
- 3. All winnings are subject to Internal Revenue Service rules and regulations pertaining to withholding of tax and the reporting of earnings.
- APHA may cancel this program at any time and refund money if it determines participation is insufficient to justify the program.
- 5. Payout will be based on the number of slots sold in each class, maximum of 30 slots and distributed based on fastest times.
